
Mid-Coast Corridor Transit Project

- Extension of Trolley Blue Line from Downtown to UTC Transit Center
- 10.9 miles of new LRT tracks
- 9 LRT Stations
- 3 miles of LRT fall within or adjacent to Caltrans R/W
- Two I-5 Crossings



Elvira to Morena Double Track

- Double Track Heavy Rail extension over Balboa Ave and Under SR52
- 3 miles of new tracks
- Project is within existing MTS R/W



San Diego River Bridge Double Track

- Double Track Heavy Rail
 Bridge over San Diego River
- 1 mile of new double track
- Project is within existing MTS
 R/W and crosses under I-8

WHAT IS THE MCTC CONSTRUCTION BENCH? AND WHY?

- DBE & SBE Subcontractor and Supplier Pre-Qualification
- Qualified Firms are Short-Listed for Future Subcontracting Opportunities
- MCTC will reach out to the Construction Bench when certain subcontracting or supply scopes are needed
- Simplifies the procurement process for both MCTC and the DBE and/or SBE firms
- Quote-based bidding rather than proposals
- Bidding opportunities between 2016 and 2020

Note – Being qualified on the Construction Bench does not guarantee future bidding opportunities or contracts with MCTC

HOW TO GET ON THE CONSTRUCTION BENCH

Fill out the Construction Bench Questionnaire and submit to MCTC via the MidCoast Vendor Portal (Planetbids) by 01/29/2016

Qualifications:

- Identify your scope of work
- Confirm DBE and/or SBE status
- Confirm Buy America, certified payroll, and prevailing wage experience
- List any previous rail corridor experience
- Confirm Union status must be signatory to at least one of the following crafts: Carpenters, Laborers, Masons, and/or Operators;
 OR Sign a One-Time Job Labor Agreement
- List company safety statistics
- Confirm licensed, bonded, and insured
- List Department of Industrial Relations (DIR) registration number,
 Contractor's License numbers, and Company's NAICS codes


